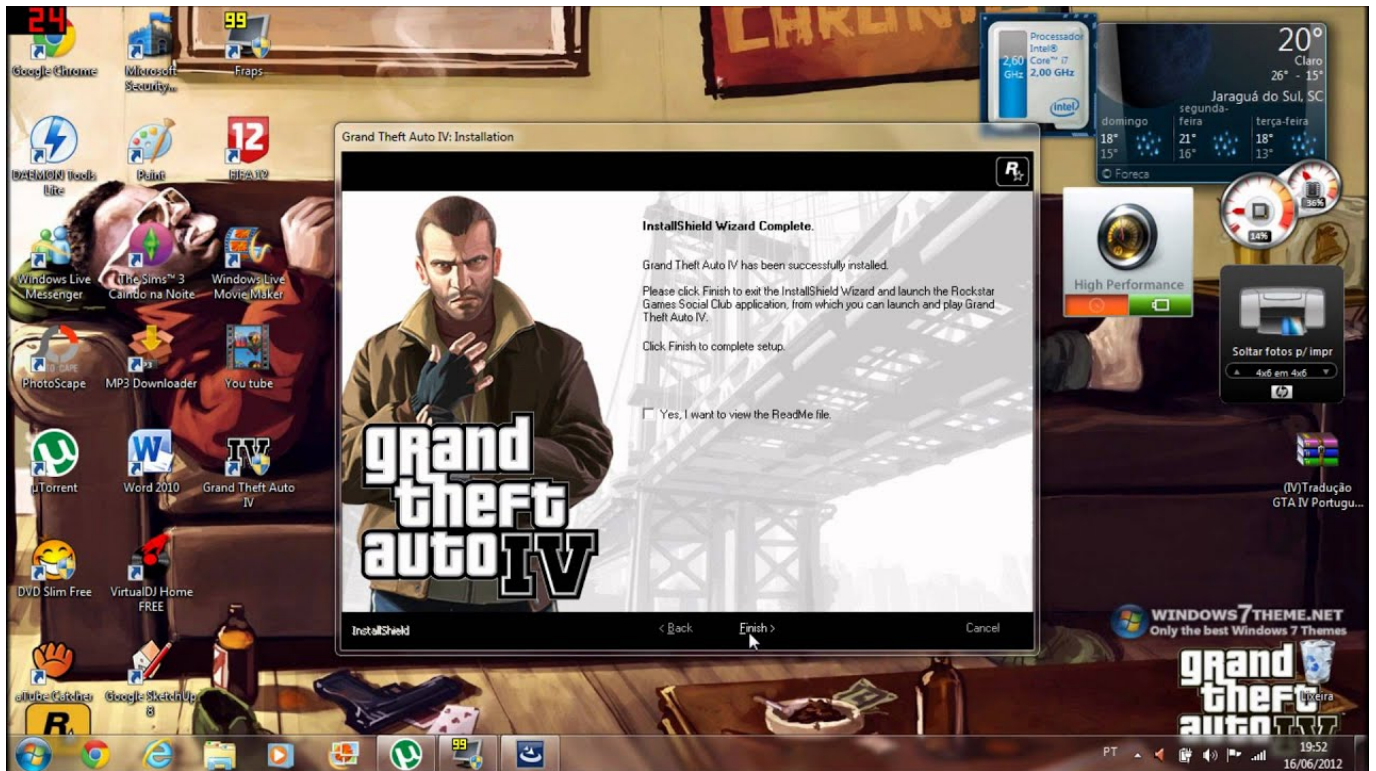

Q: How to turn off auto-renew on iOS6? I cannot figure out how to turn off auto-renew on my iOS6 device. The app does not show the option to turn off auto-renew. I have no idea what the issue is. Does anyone know how to fix this? A: Have you tried removing it from the list of purchased apps in the App Store? The Times cannot avoid the truth that America is a nation of Christians, a majority of whom want President Trump and the Republicans to be in control. The Times is either unable or unwilling to admit the truth. In its article, the Times refers to President Trump as "white nationalist." The Left hates Trump for his patriotism and desire to protect America's borders. And for these reasons, he is "white nationalist" and "fascist."
